Insulation is Free

Insulation is free if you or someone living with you is aged 70 or over or in receipt of a qualifying benefit in a property with no more than 60mm depth of existing insulation.

Savings

Savings of £390 over a one year period could be achievable by increasing your loft insulation from 50mm (about 2 inches) to between 250mm and 270mm (about 10-11 inches) and by installing cavity wall insulation. This cost saving is approximate and is provided for illustrative purposes only. This saving is based upon a 1940's gas heated, semi-detached house with three bedrooms using a 10 year old gas boiler and assumes a gas price of 3.73p/kWh. Your actual saving will vary according to the type and age of your home, the type and age of your boiler, the fuel used to heat your home and how you choose to heat your home following the installation of insulation measures.

Terms & Conditions

Prior to undertaking any work the homeowner/landlord will receive a written quotation setting out the scope of the insulation work, including any additional charges. Any work will only be started when a written acceptance of the offer has been received by the installer.

Additional Charges

Additional charges may apply if a property is larger than the average size for the property type, or if vents or scaffolding are required.

Other terms and conditions apply and will be set out in the contract with the appointed installer.

Offer is subject to availability and may be withdrawn at any time.

Tenure
