

Further Public Consultation on the reconstruction of Bell Bridge

The Parish Council has been asked to work with the construction team to create a suitable interpretive feature to record the heritage of the old bridge. The planners want this feature to utilise masonry salvaged from the old bridge and to provide discussion on the history of Bell Bridge. It is suggested this be located on the west bank and include a landscaped and seating area.

Options will be discussed at the next Parish Council Meeting at 7.30p.m. on 24 May in Welton Village Hall for agreement at the Cumbria County Council Planning meeting on 3 July 2017.
